WHAT WE OFFER

Angel Shed's Inclusivity Training is for organisations who are looking to work more inclusively – be that within their staff team, with service users or in approaching work culture.

In this training, we will share practical tools, knowledge, and strategies on inclusive leadership, communication, and language. Incorporating a variety of learning styles, and utilising our background in performing arts, the training is creative, active, and engaging.

Our training is typically accessed by arts organisations, education providers and youth charities. However, the bespoke nature of our offer allows anyone to deepen their understanding and practical approach to inclusivity including customer-facing teams and client-orientated professionals.

We deliver half-day and full-day training sessions with both face-to-face and online options to suit different group sizes and budgets. Included in our offer:

BESPOKE CONTENT

We create a bespoke training package for each organisation we partner with, working with you to deliver training that best suits your requirements. Please find an overview of our most frequently accessed modules below.

WHAT IS INCLUSIVITY?

We will reflect on inclusivity together, looking at inclusive strategies used by Angel Shed and explore how these could work for your organisation.

POSITIVE BEHAVIOUR SUPPORT

We will learn about inclusive strategies for managing challenging behaviour: exploring triggers, discussing prevention and understanding how we can respond safely and inclusively.

CURATING INCLUSIVE SPACES

We will explore approaches and considerations for ensuring our working spaces are inclusive for those with a range of disabilities and neurodiversities, including dyslexia, autism and ADHD.

INCLUSIVE LANGUAGE

We will interrogate commonly used language and phrases, discussing alternatives in order to be more inclusive, including in regard to disability, race and gender.

INCLUSIVE RECRUITMENT

We will explore practical approaches to consider when hiring new members of your team in order to reach and support individuals with a diversity of lived experiences.

INCLUSIVE COMMUNICATION

We will consider practical approaches to supporting communication: including with those who have English as an additional language, are neurodivergent, or non-speaking.

INCLUSIVE GAMES

We will play a selection of fun circle games that inspire confidence, build team work and support energy and focus, analysing adaptations for different access requirements.
